OUR DISCIPLINE POLICY:

Our goal is to create a positive, secure atmosphere for your child. Teachers will clearly state and model acceptable behavior in the classroom. The teachers will carefully observe the classroom at all times, noticing and praising positive behavior. Your child will be taught that it is not acceptable to hurt another person, either emotionally or physically.

“Time Outs” are not used in our school. If a child cannot be successfully redirected, the teacher will ask the child to sit down for a “cooling off period”. When the child has calmed down, the teacher will speak one on one with the child reminding him of the school rules.
